Introduction:

RIGHT-HAND AND LEFT-HAND sides are determined by facing in the direction of forward travel.

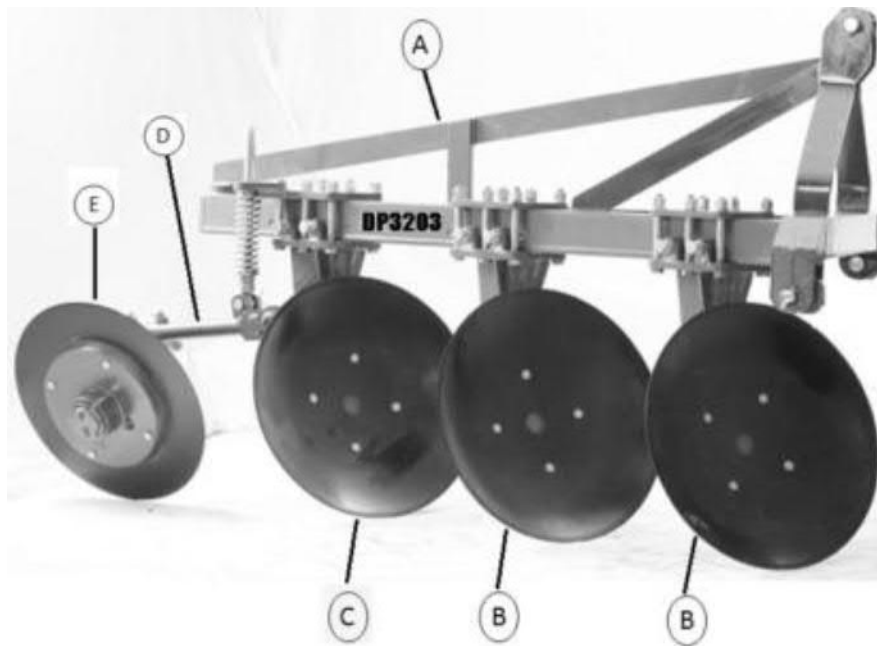
WRITE PRODUCT IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS (P.I.N.) in the Specification or Identification Numbers Section.

Accurately record all the numbers to help in tracing the machine should it be stolen. File the identification numbers in a secure place; do not keep them on the machine.

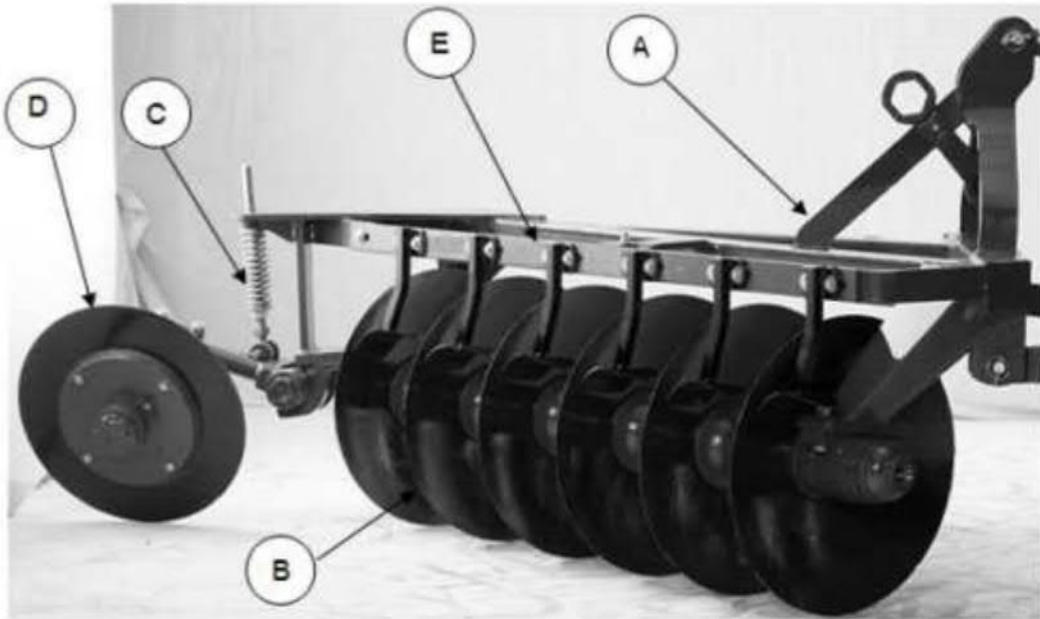
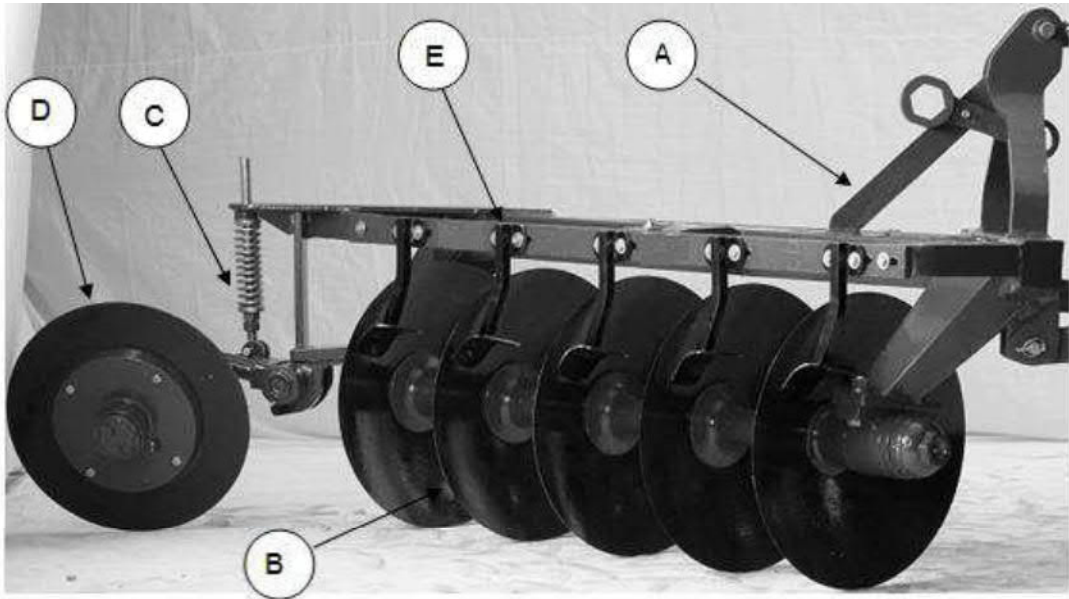

Should the equipment be abused, or modified to change its performance beyond the original factory specifications, the warranty will become void and field improvements may be denied.
