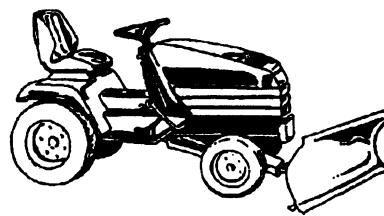

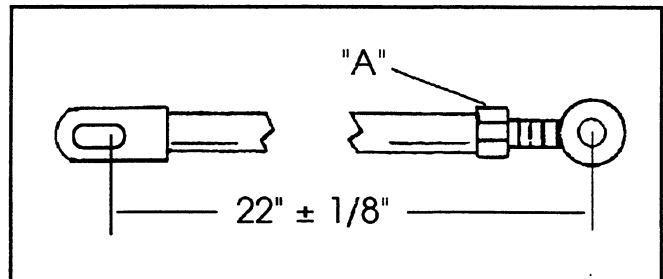
## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION CORRECTIONS

The following corrections and clarifications are necessary to insure the 48 inch Front Blade is set up properly. Follow the information below, rather than those noted instructions and illustrations in the operator's manual.

### PAGE 10

#### Step 4 & Center Illustration

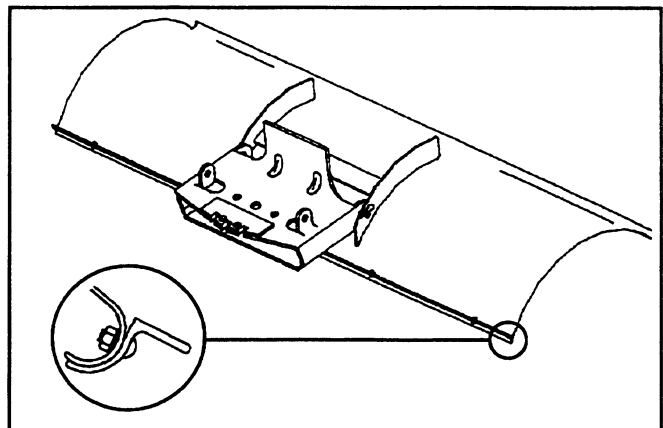
4. Assemble the push rod and adjust its length to 22 inches,  $\pm 1/8$  inch, from the centerline of the hole in the adjustment stud to the front of the slot in the rod yoke end. Do not tighten jam nut "A" at this time.



### PAGE 11

#### Step 1 & Top Illustration

1. Fasten the cutting edge/skid bar to the moldboard with the flat edge forward as illustrated with 3/8-16 x 1 carriage bolts, flat and lockwashers and nuts. Adjust the cutting edge to the center of the slots in the moldboard and tighten the fasteners.
