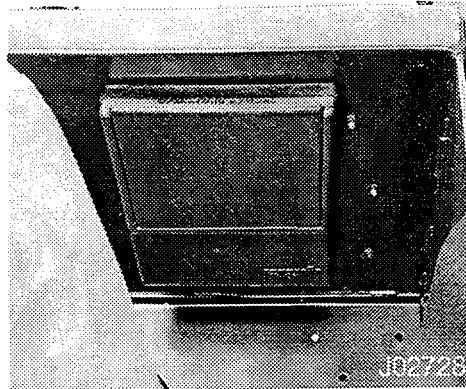

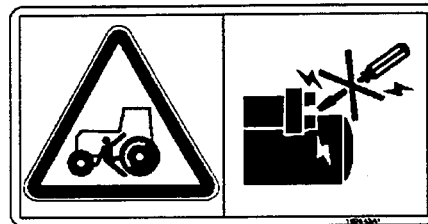
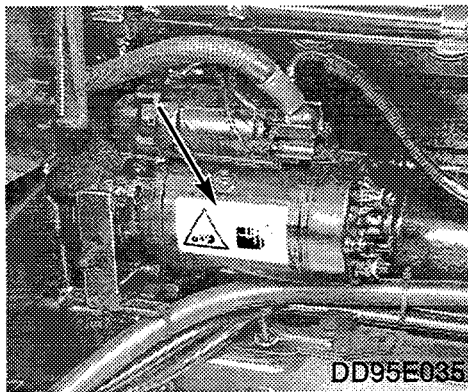
**⚠ GENERAL SAFETY AND ACCIDENT PREVENTION REGULATIONS ⚠**

- Start the engine and drive the tractor only from the operator's seat.

**⚠ LEAVING THE TRACTOR ⚠**

- When leaving the tractor, stop the engine. Make sure that the tractor will not roll away (apply park lock, use a wheel wedge) .
- Lower implement or equipment to the ground before leaving the tractor.
- Put all controls into neutral and stop the engine. Remove the key from the keyswitch and lock the operator's cab (when equipped).
- Never leave the tractor unattended as long as the engine is still running.
- Never leave the operator's platform/cab whilst the tractor is in motion.

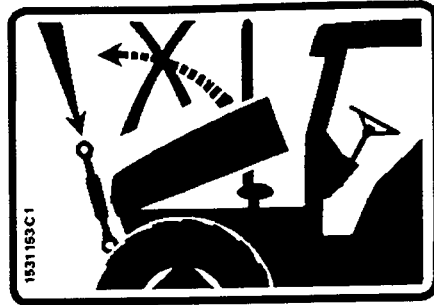
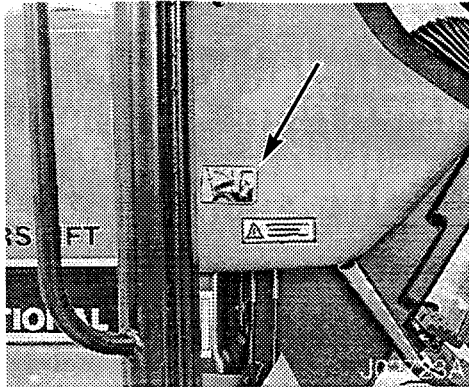

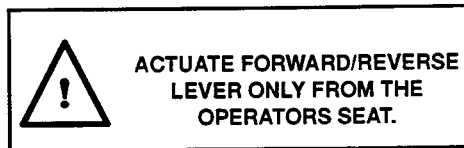
