---

## Safety-Alert Symbol

Read and recognize safety information. Be alert to the potential for personal injury when you see this safety-alert symbol.

On your machine safety labels, the words **DANGER**, **WARNING**, and **CAUTION** are used with this safety-alert symbol. **DANGER** identifies the most serious hazards. In this manual, the word **CAUTION** and this symbol call attention to safety messages.



## Machine Safety Labels

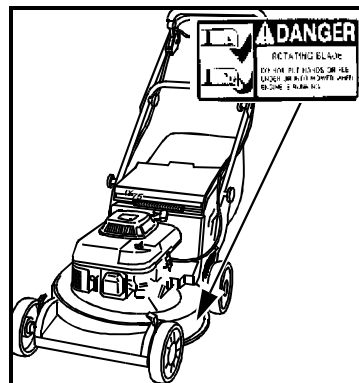
**DANGER** - Keep Hands and Feet Away.

Cutting Blades.



**DANGER** - Rotating Blade

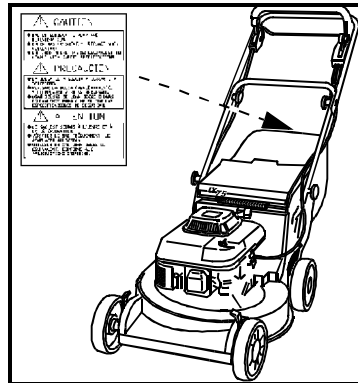
Do not put hands or feet under or into mower when engine is running.



## SAFETY SIGNS

### CAUTION

- Bag is subject to wear and deterioration.
- Check bag frequently, replace when necessary.
- Use John Deere bag or equivalent to comply with safety specifications.



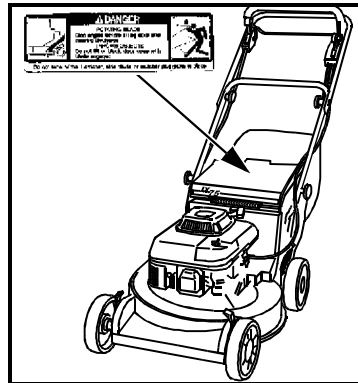
### DANGER

#### ROTATING BLADE

Stop engine before lifting door and cleaning discharge.

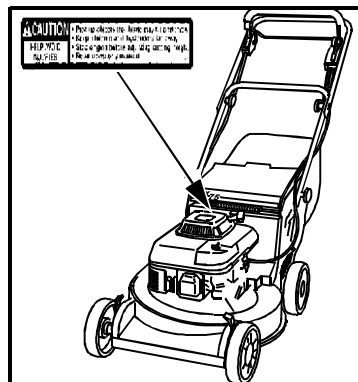
#### THROWN OBJECTS

Do not lift or block door open with blade engaged.



### CAUTION - Help Avoid Injuries

- Pick up objects that blade may hit and throw
- Keep children and bystanders far away
- Stop engine before adjusting cutting height
- Read operator's manual
