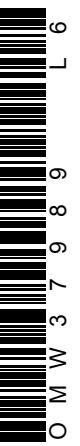

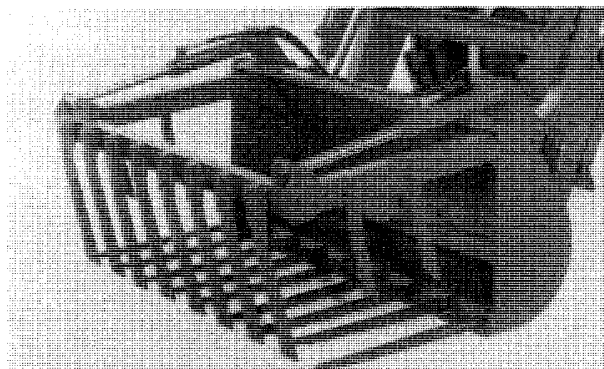
This manual should be considered a permanent part of your machine and should remain with the machine when you sell it.

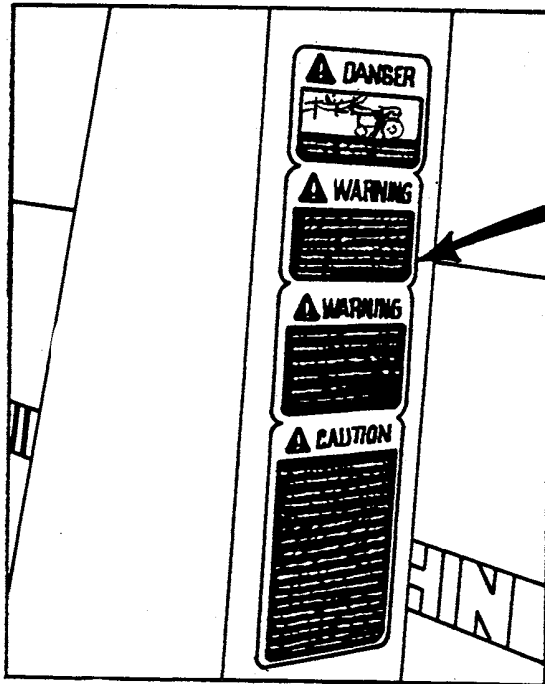
