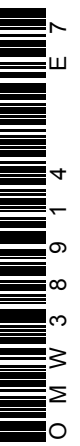

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Introduction

Measurements in this manual are U.S. customary units and their metric equivalents.

Right-hand and left-hand sides are determined by facing in the direction of forward travel.

Write product identification numbers in the Specifications section. Accurately record all the numbers to help in tracing the machine should it be stolen. Your dealer also needs these numbers when you order parts. If this manual is kept on the machine, also file the identification numbers in a secure place off the machine.

Warranty is provided as part of John Deere's support program for customers who operate and maintain their equipment as described in this manual.

The warranty does not cover:

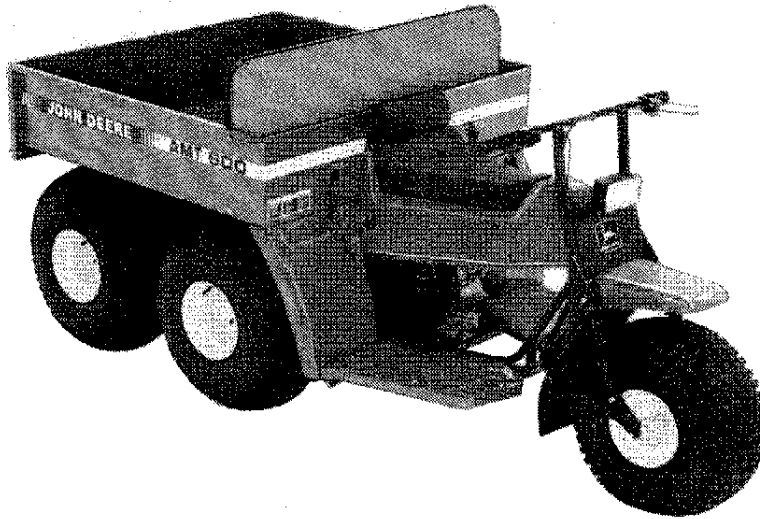
A—Products which have been altered or modified in ways not approved by John Deere, including setting fuel delivery above specifications or otherwise over-powering of products.

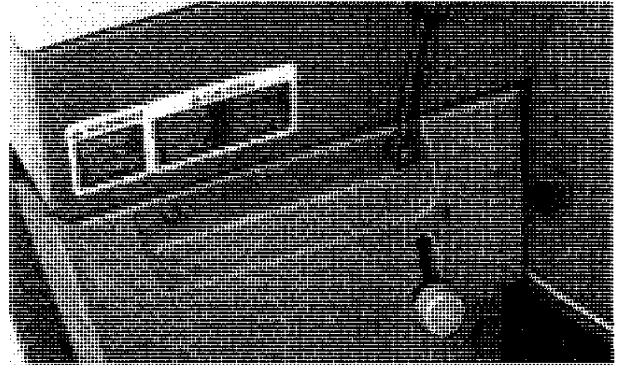

⚠ WARNING

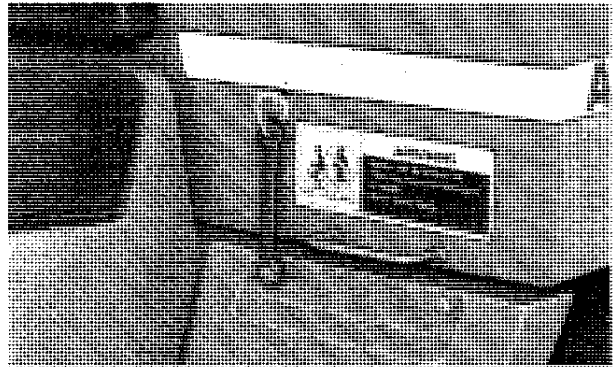
HELP PREVENT INJURY OR DEATH FROM MACHINE OVERTURN


1. Reduce load when operating over rough or hilly terrain.
2. Reduce speed when turning or when operating around obstacles, on rough ground, or on slopes.
3. Use of a helmet is recommended when operating in rough terrain.

⚠ CAUTION

1. Read Operators Manual before operating vehicle.
2. Keep all riders off.
3. This machine intended for off road use only.
4. Keep loadguard and all shields in place.
5. Inflate tires to 5 PSI (35 kPa). Overinflation or underinflation could adversely affect control of machine.
6. The maximum pay load capacity is 600 lb. (272 kg).
7. Securely anchor all loads.
8. Stop engine before refueling.
9. Stop engine, set parking brake, and shift to neutral before dismounting.
10. Remove key if leaving vehicle unattended.

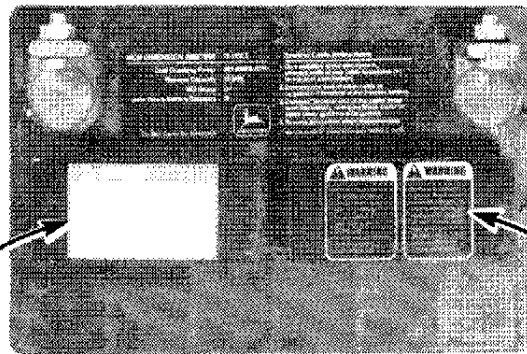

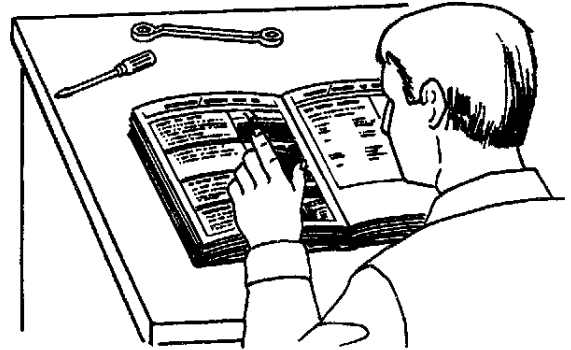

Unauthorized modifications to the machine may impair the function and/or safety and affect machine life.

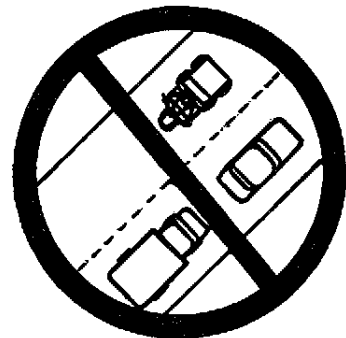

KEEP OFF ROADWAYS

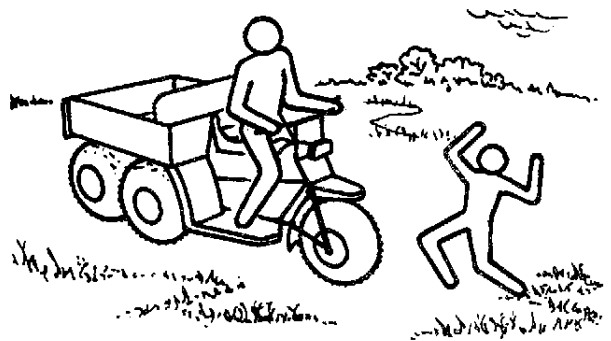
PROTECT CHILDREN
